

We couldn't be happier with the strong voter turnout in our first election -- and significantly the first election in which members of a U.S. working equitation group have been asked to elect their leadership. In all, 68.3% of U.S. adult members casting a vote, ranging from a high of 77.1% in Region 4 to a low of 45% in Region 2.

Progress Toward a Single Set of Rules: Input Needed!

Representatives from WE United are scheduled to meet with representatives from WEIAUSA and USFWE in November of 2016 to reach agreement on a single set of rules and dressage tests to be used at all Working Equitation competitions within the United States.

An important part of this process is getting input from those who compete in the sport throughout Nort America. To that end, we have published a survey, open to all who are interested in sharing their insights on the United States' WE rules. So far, 96 people have taken the time to share their thoughts on a variety of areas in which the different sets of rules currently have differences.
